

- 2018 Theranos Dissolved


Compliance Core

- Policy What is it we do?
- Process How do we do it?
- Training This is how we do it.
- Audit Are we doing it?
- Innovate How can we do it better and more consistently?



Compliance to Customers

- Customers EXPECT Compliance
 - Every time
 - Every situation
- The Bad Thing WILL Happen
- Compliance in the face of the BAD THING
 - Legal?
 - Prompt, effective investigation, remediation and correction
 - Demonstrable program to detect, correct and innovate to mitigate risk

When The Bad Thing Happens - OR Someone Doesn't Like the Outcome

Business/Compliance

- Engage legal immediately
- Identify if there may be fault arising from your company
- Prepare to immediately resolve issue if you caused the loss
- Use the situation as a catalyst for process/production improvement



Legal

- Provide all information you would otherwise have to give
- Cooperate on everything that does not harm your case
- Look for early resolution or disposition
- Fight like crazy on everything else!
